do our best to limit the impact. As part of our system of controls, can I please remind parents of secondary aged students to keep up the twice weekly lateral flow testing during term time, particularly on the day before we come back after half term (Sunday 31 October). We were pleased to see a large number of secondary children received their flu and COVID vaccinations last Monday which can only help in our efforts to reduce cases.










The focus for Term 2 is "BEING INDEPENDENT"

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We are building up their independence and are aiming to get them to make it completely independently, for themselves and friends!







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

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
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This term was the start of Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award!
